Minutes: Minutes of meeting held on 9th May 2016 were adopted

1. Matters Arising: None
2. Community Police Officer's Report: On 16th May a report was received about a drunk male on Leckie Road. He was subsequently traced and assistance provided.

On 23rd May there was a 2 vehicle collision at the junction of the A811 and B8075. No injuries were sustained.

The Air Weapons and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2015 comes into effect on 31st December 2016. This new law will require any person who possesses, purchases, uses or acquires an air weapon to have a certificate to hold them legally.

The Police Scotland Public Consultation Survey was launched on 7th April 2016 and is on-line. This allows anyone to provide feedback to Police Scotland on a variety of topics and what local people feel policing priorities should be in their communities. The survey takes about 15 minutes to complete and everyone is encouraged to participate in it.

6. Road Safety

Phase 2 of the work has still to be carried out. Lovat to enquire re present position.

Speeding on Manse Brae is still a problem – police to be asked to monitor the situation.

The give way signs at the bottom of Manse Brae have still not been reinstated. Lovat has enquired about this on a number of occasions but has not had the courtesy of a response from Stirling Council.

7. Windfarm

The question of the distribution of funds amongst the villages has still not been resolved. There was some discussion on this subject regarding the distribution of funds coming to the village and the possible setting up of a Committee to administer this. Information to assist this has been received from Kilmadock Trust and Pam will provide further guidance notes in due course.

8. AOCB

- a. There is some confusion regarding the ownership of the path between Stevenson Street and Drummond Place. Further enquiries have to be made.
- b. Notice has been received regarding Bus Service changes to the C12 service. There will now not be any service in the evenings. There is a notice on the village notice board about this.
